THE LAZARET ON PEEL ISLAND

Formed in 1999, the Friends of Peel Island Association (FOPIA) has been active in raising awareness of Peel Island's cultural and natural heritage.

In recent years, the island has been declared a National Park with Conservation and Recreational Areas and is managed by the Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS) and the Quandamooka Yoolooburrabee Aboriginal Corporation (QYAC).

Access to all but the Horseshoe Bay area is restricted to the public.

FOPIA members work closely with QPWS on Peel Island in relation to:

- maintenance of the Heritage Listed buildings
- care of the Cemetery
- weed eradication on the island

and a number of associated activities.

With FOPIA's assistance, a church service is held on the island annually.
